



30% cost coverage with caps listed

- Solar Panel Installation 30%
- Insulation Materials* \$1200
- Windows/Skylights* \$600
- Exterior Doors* \$250 per door, \$500
- Heat Pump for Heat/Cool \$2000/year
- Efficient Equip for Heat/Cool* \$600
- EV Charger \$1000
- EV Car, New \$7500
- EV Car, Old \$4000
- Heat Pump Water Heater \$2000/year
- Efficient Water Heating Equip* \$600
- Electric Panel Upgrade* \$600
- Battery Storage 30%
- Energy Audits \$150
